Minutes:

1. **Deciding and communicating goals and initiatives** (Jackie Anderson)
Due to COVID, a review of some school documents for 2020 has not occurred. Plans for home reviewing in pairs and collation of feedback will now occur in term 4, depending on COVID restrictions.
2. **School Strategic Plan** (Jackie Anderson) – see document –
This document will require a review and rewrite early Term 1, 2021 as it expires in 2021. Is required to be sent to Regional Office.
3. **Student Code of Conduct** (Tracey Brose) - see document-
First school in Queensland to complete this process. TMSHS developed the document and had it checked by legals, other schools are now reviewing our documents as an exemplar. TMSHS are utilising this when determining Student Disciplinary Decisions. All schools will be required to have developed their own document by 2021.
Exemption Process has changed considerably, documentation, conditions etc. have changed significantly.
4. **Resource Hire 2021** (Tracey Brose)
Laptop hire fees for 2021 have increased, see sheet regarding summary of reasons and increased costs. Also, new SRS system (see folder of detailed breakdown) of every individual item used by students in each year level and subject. Tracey explained how detailed this process now is and how other schools have not yet started on this time consuming process, however it is now legislated that all schools are required to have completed this for parents and Regional Office. This breakdown will be reviewed annually.
5. **School Opinion Survey Results 2019** (Jackie Anderson) - see summary sheet –
Went through most positive increase/most negative responses from parents, students, teaching staff and staff. Explained to students how algorithm is utilised to determine which students are to be surveyed (electronically) to submit anonymous responses. 2020 SOS has been completed, results are due back in October in time for next School Council Meeting (delayed due to COVID).



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6. **Saturday Detention** (Tracey Brose) - see sheet of statistics/data -
Very positive results and students' completion of qualification certificates are outstanding, on average, two qualifications per students has been achieved each Saturday.
7. **Student Achievement Data Term 2** (Jackie Anderson) - see graphs attached -
Explanation of N rating due in part to COVID i.e. curriculum/assessment set for students to work on whilst at home/zoom, overall how this experience was observed by teachers, parents and students on the whole.
8. **SATE EXTERNAL EXAMS 2020** (Jackie Anderson)
Will begin on Week 4, Term 4, similar to QCS around expectations, conditions etc. TMSHS is adopting additional Line Day's in-between to enable our Year 11 and 12 students' revision and completion of assessment items (applied subjects).
